Family Eligibility:

- An adult (18 years or older) has at least 1 child in the home (17 years or younger).
 - An 18-year-old child qualifies as long as they are still in high school (*a child must be under the age of 18 unless the child will complete high school before his/her 19th birthday*).
 - An unborn child also qualifies as a child under the age of 18.

Income Eligibility*:

At or below 185% of FPL

- Between 185% FPL and 250% FPL, but is eligible due to one or more of the following conditions:
 - Homeless: in shelter, staying in a vehicle, on the street, doubled-up with family or friends, in a motel/hotel, or in a place not meant for human habitation.
 - At-Risk of Homelessness: ten (10) or more days behind on rent/mortgage or utility payments; at risk of eviction/foreclosure; underemployed, or experiencing a job loss; and/or experiencing a housing crisis.
