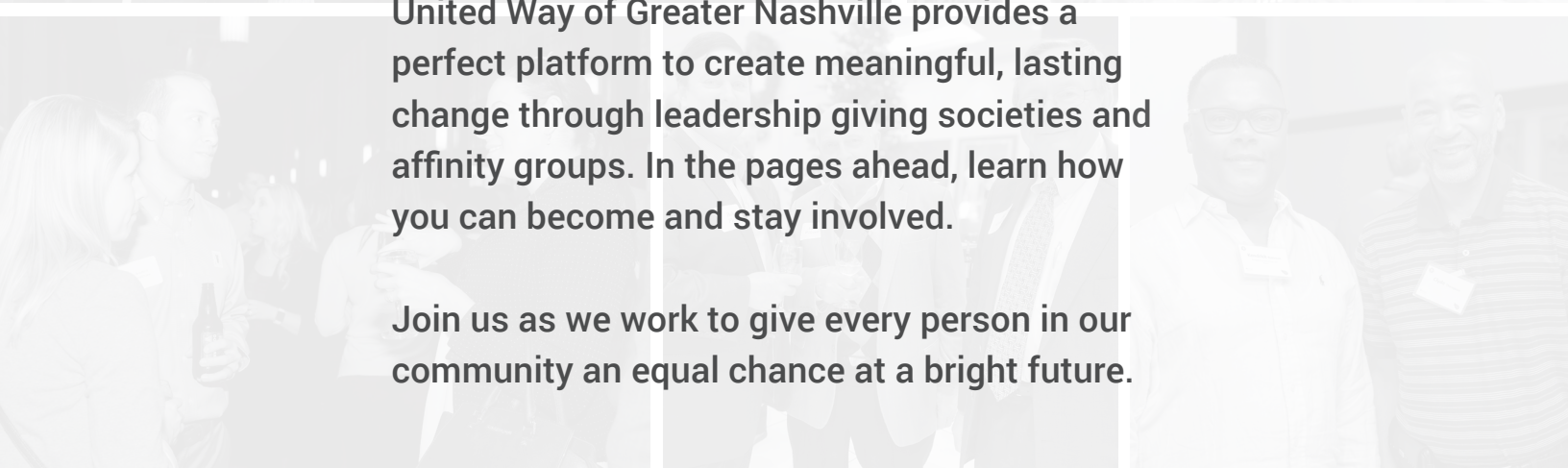
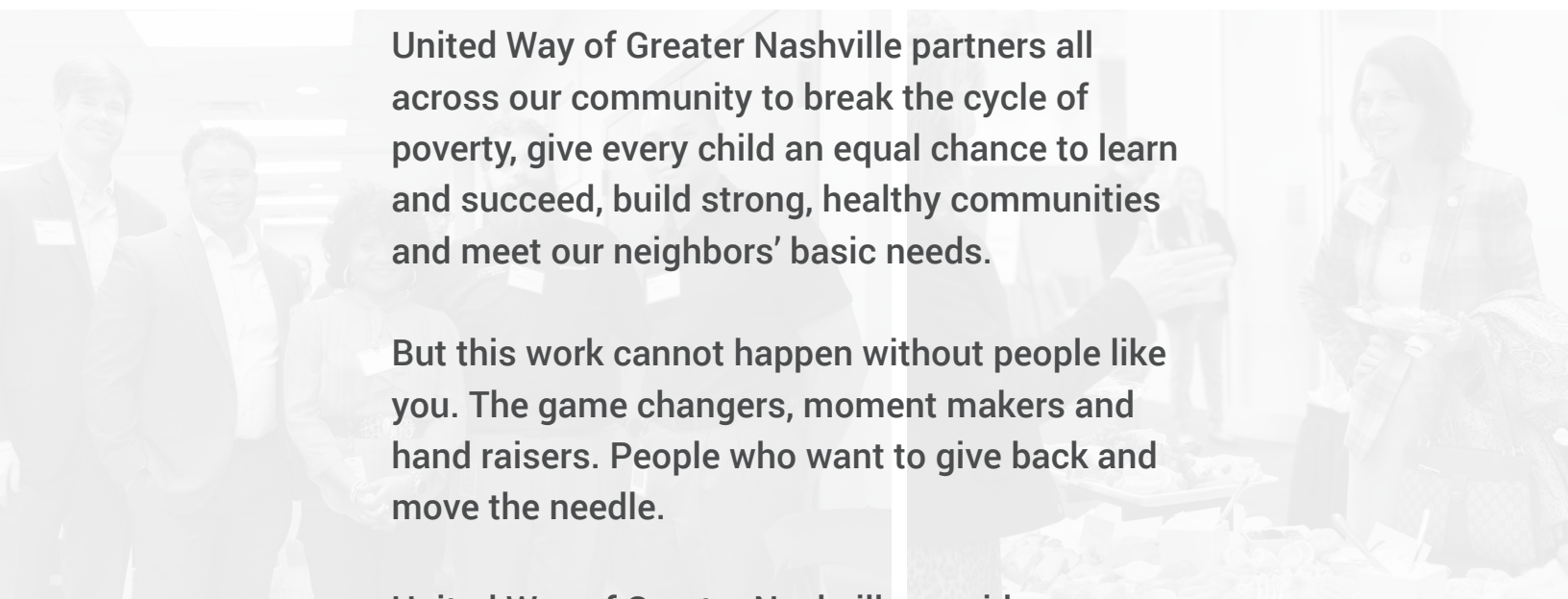
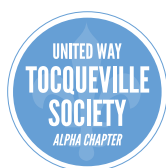

Since inception, Tocqueville Society members have invested more than \$10 billion in the work of United Way worldwide and nearly \$150 million in Greater Nashville.
