**Over the last five years, we have had an average operational overhead ratio of 8.9%**, compared to the national average of 25%.

Across our region, we face extraordinary challenges such as lack of affordable housing, low childhood literacy rates and households struggling to make ends meet. We are improving systems by:

- Building and strengthening collaborative infrastructures
- Building diverse stakeholder commitment
- Sparking collective action among stakeholders

## HOW WE WORK

1. Program and support funding is received through grants and other sources.
2. Corporate and individual donations are received.
3. Local agencies then apply for funding through our Community Investment Funding process.
4. Volunteers review the applications and recommend allocations to our board of directors.
5. We then distribute the funds to over 150 local partner agencies in one or more of our focus areas.
