- Program and support funding is received through grants and other sources.

- Local agencies then apply for funding through our Community Investment Funding process.
- Volunteers review the applications and recommend allocations to our board of directors.
- We then distribute the funds to over 150 local partner agencies in one or more of our focus areas.
