PHYLANICE NASHE

Phylanice Nashe is a retired attorney, entrepreneur, and philanthropist with more than two decades of leadership experience across law, IT, manufacturing, and e-learning. Her career has included serving as CEO of the Nashe Law Group, serving as a principal of Innertainment Delivery Systems which was acquired in 2017. Phylanice also served as a principal of MaxxContent (MC) where she guided the development of the country's first correctional grade online and offline e-learning platform. MC was also one of the largest aggregators of educational content in the world, with over 200,000 titles. MC was acquired in 2021.

Phylanice's community engagement reflects her passion for education, entrepreneurship, and criminal justice reform. She currently serves on the Leadership Nashville Alumni Association Board and the Executive Board of the Nashville Symphony, where she is the immediate past Chair of the Education Committee and continues to contribute on the Governance and Artistic Planning & Community Engagement Committees. She has also served on the Curatorial and Education Committee of the National Museum of African American Music and as Entrepreneur in Residence at the Nashville Business Incubation Center. In addition, she has been an active leader in the Williamson County Chapter of Jack and Jill of America, most recently as Legislative Chair.

Philanthropy plays a central role in her life. Alongside her husband, Dr. Turner Nashe Jr., she co-founded The Bridge Resource Partnership Fund, which has deployed more than one million dollars in low-interest loans to support Black-owned businesses in Middle Tennessee. She also manages the Nashe Family Donor Advised Fund, which continues to provide support for a wide range of community initiatives, including exhibitions at the Frist Museum. Phylanice also hosts The Phylanice Nashe Experience, a podcast that highlights the voices of entrepreneurs and business leaders and explores their experiences balancing professional success with family life.
