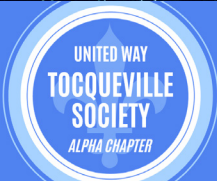

THE VALUE AND POWER OF A TOCQUEVILLE ANNUAL GIFT

Here are examples of how a Tocqueville gift creates a lasting impact in our community.

Ensure every child enters kindergarten ready to learn, develops the reading skills they need to thrive and is supported in and out of school

- Books for 833 children for a year through Imagination Library of Middle TN
- Helps 92 children to increase their literacy and/or numeracy skills

Build strong, healthy communities by providing resources for improved wellness and community connections.

- Assists 58 individuals with services to improve their physical health
- Stabilizes 177 individuals in a crisis or disaster emergency

Support individuals and families facing housing and financial challenges

- Gives food assistance to 380 families of four to improve their food security
- Provides training opportunities for 73 people to improve their job skills and self-sufficiency

This year marks the 45th year of United Way of Greater Nashville's Tocqueville Society Alpha Chapter.

In 1981, Dr. Thomas F. Frist, Jr. envisioned an alliance of community and business leaders who would work collectively to address our community's most pressing needs. He partnered with 27 other Nashville visionaries to create the Alexis de Tocqueville Society Alpha Chapter.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY FOR MORE THAN 100 YEARS, UNITED WAY OF GREATER NASHVILLE IS TRUSTED AND EFFECTIVE.

Through our Community Fund, we help better identify the critical needs in the communities we serve, which ebb and flow throughout time and across counties.

Our support makes a huge difference for our partners. Of the 180+ nonprofit agencies we fund, nearly 30 percent have a staff of five or less people.

We hold a 4-star Charity Navigator ranking (score of 100%) and have a Candid Gold Transparency designation.

Over the last five years UWGN has had an average operational overhead ratio of 10%, compared to the national nonprofit average of 25%. This means 90% of your donations directly support our programs and services.

We are a proud member of Volunteer Organizations Active in Disaster for Davidson County and the Long-Term Recovery Groups for Clarksville Montgomery County and Davidson County.

We are part of the growing network of local employers dedicated to building a more sustainable economy through Nashville Living Wage.
